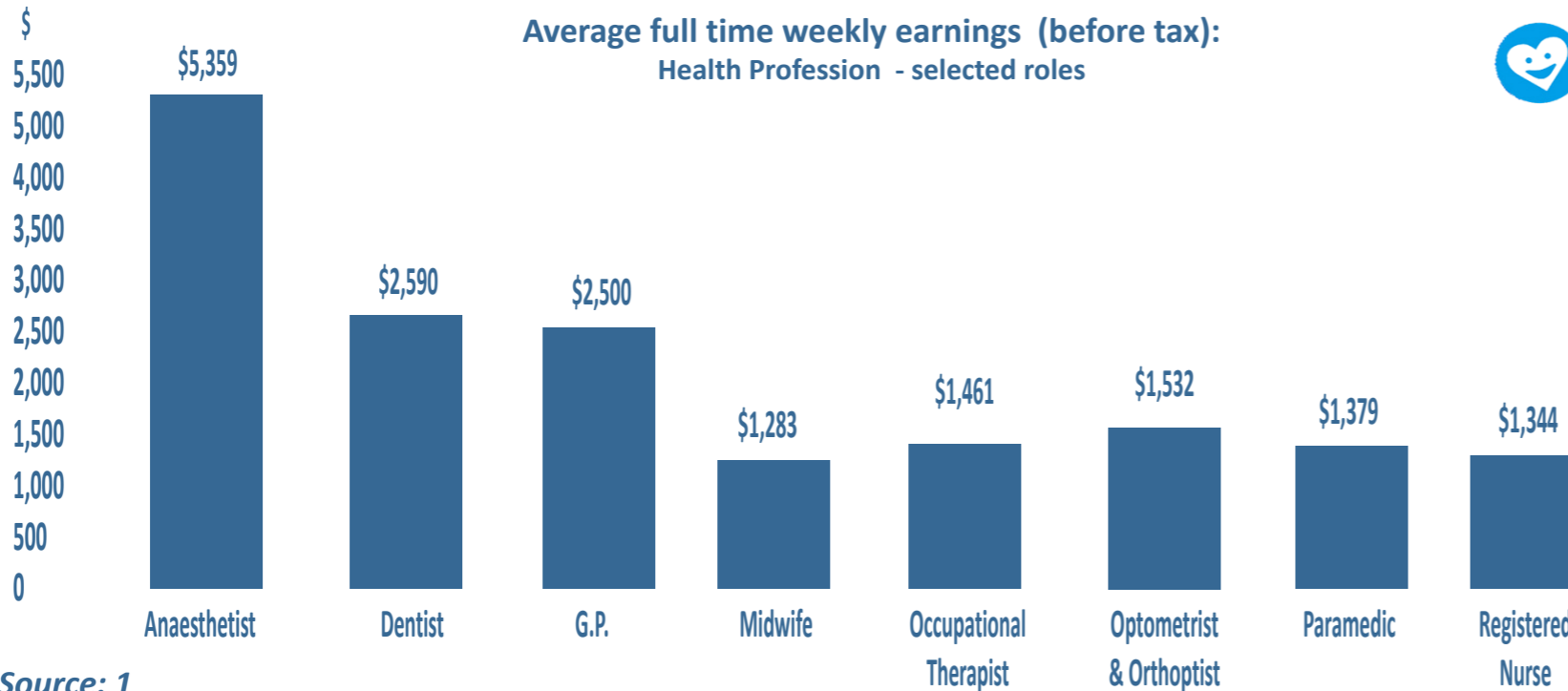


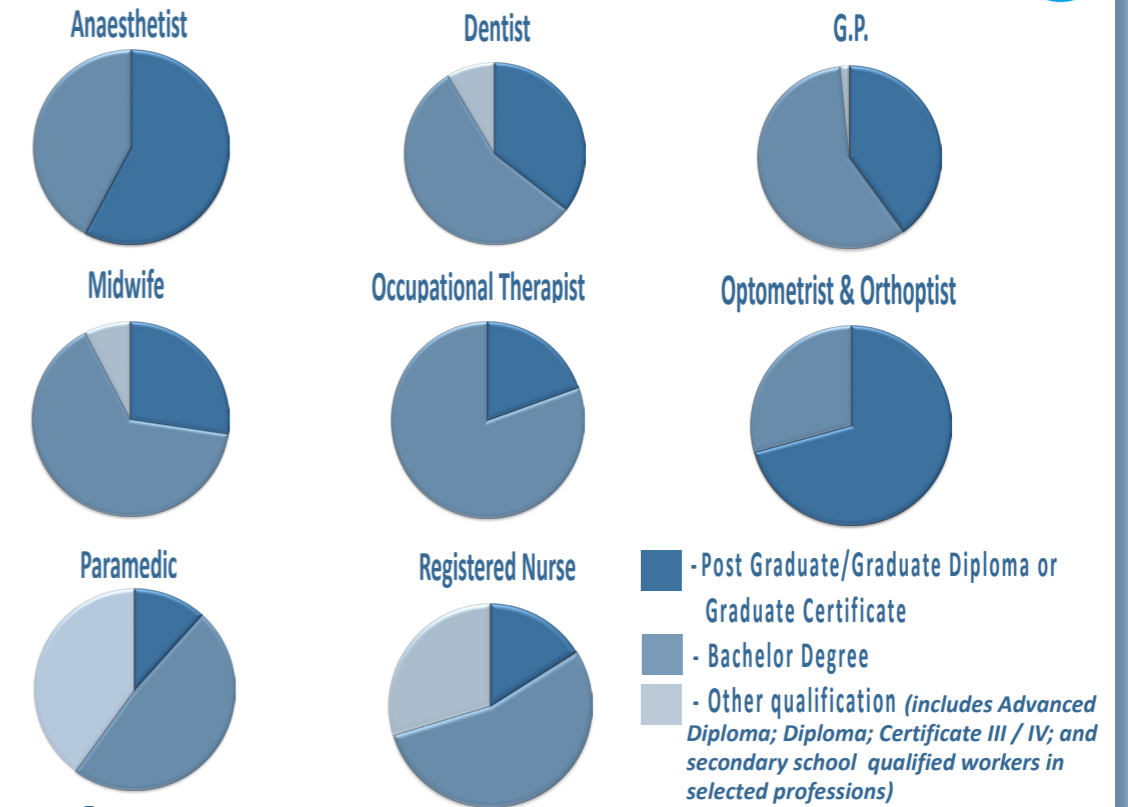

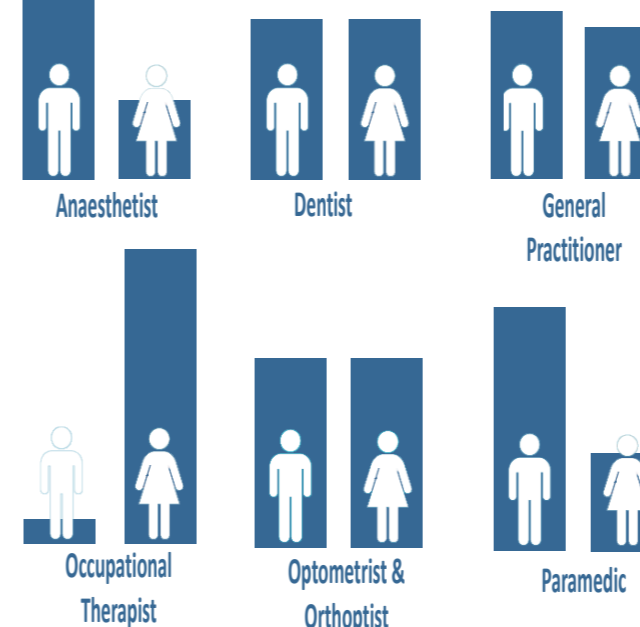
The Health Care and Social Assistance sector is a strongly growing area of employment - more than 1.5 million employees (13% of all Australian workers).

By 2020, more than 250,200 additional Health jobs are expected. Allied Health professions account for 30% of all Health sector jobs. Aged and Disabled Care is the second largest occupation group (after Registered Nurses).

Looking forward to November 2020, employment levels for Occupational Therapists and Paramedics are expected to grow very strongly. Employment for Generalist Medical Practitioners is also expected to grow very strongly, with job openings for the next five years expected to be between 10,001 and 25,000.
